



## Keep your shower enclosure as clean as the day it was installed

Residues from hard water, high humidity, soap and shampoo can quickly build up on the surface of your shower enclosure. In order to keep your glass looking clean - it is recommended that you wipe-down or squeegee after each use. Getting these contaminants off the glass will save you time later during your general cleaning.

For most homeowners, using a soft cloth or sponge with **mild detergents** works well once every 15 showers. A solution of 50% vinegar and 50% water is a safe and cost effective solution for regular cleaning. For hard water conditions, the frequency will likely be greater and stronger detergents may be necessary.

There are plenty of cleaners in the marketplace from which to choose. **Avoid cleaners that include abrasives or harsh chemicals** (i.e. ammonia, bleach, oxide or acid-based solutions). Be especially cautious with "leave on" or proposed "self-cleaning" products. These products can create the greatest risk if they are not rinsed off in a timely or effective manner. Glass is relatively soft and porous - allowing these chemical contaminants to lodge themselves into its pores and make it look dirty... permanently.

If you have hard water or are concerned about your cleaning frequency - glass protection products, such as *Diamon-Fusion*, can be applied. These products act like a "non-stick" cookware surface, making the water bead up and fall down away from the glass. *Diamon-Fusion* is a product that has been used globally for over 18 years and is available through Splendor dealers.
